#### **DUTIES OF SPECIAL INSPECTORS**

(Excerpt from Section 1701 Uniform Building Code.)

- 1. The special inspector shall observe the work assigned for conformance with the approved design drawings and specifications.
- 2. The special inspector shall furnish inspection reports to the building official, the engineer or architect of record, and other designated persons. All discrepancies shall be brought to the immediate attention of the contractor for correction, then, if incorrect, to the proper design authority and to the building official.
- 3. The special inspector shall submit a final signed report stating whether the work requiring special inspection was, to the best of his knowledge, in conformance with the approved plans and specifications and the applicable workmanship provision of this code.

### ENGINEERING SITE OBSERVATIONS

Engineering site observations means the observation of materials and completed work to observe their <u>general compliance</u> with the approved permit plans. Generally, the project engineer (or architect) that has been responsible for the structural design is appointed to perform the site observations.

It should be noted that this may be in addition to the requirement for a special inspector according to Section 1701 of the State Building Code (i.e. reinforced concrete, structural steel, masonry, etc.). When these types of special inspections are required, the project engineer shall monitor the inspections performed by the special inspector.

The project engineer shall observe the general progress of the project, verify design assumptions, and then shall take appropriate action to provide for public safety.
