Cook School Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project

Monday August 15th thru Friday August 19th, road closures on Oregon Street between 2nd Court and 5th Street. Work hours will be approximately 7:00am – 5.00pm. Emery and Sons General Contractor will be replacing sanitary sewer mainline and reconnecting sewer laterals.

Road will be closed to thru traffic, local access will be allowed with short delays.

ROW Permit, McMinnville Water & Light

Utility Pole Replacement & Relocation -NE 5th Street between NE Evans and NW Birch Streets

McMinnville Water & Light will continue installing and relocating utility poles in the NE 5th Street corridor in conjunction with the Cities NE 5th Street Improvements Project. Work between NE Evans & NE Davis is planned for Monday through Wednesday Aug 15-17, and work between NW Birch & NW Adams is planned for Thursday Aug 18th. W&L crews will be working on several poles in the area clearing conflicts for the Project. There will be intermittent lane closures, and street closures of one block at a time may be necessary. Street closures and lane restrictions are allowed between 9am-3pm only. Traffic control signage and detour routes will be in place and access to local businesses will be maintained at all times.

NE 5th Street Improvements Project

Construction of storm sewer, curb extensions and handicap ramps at the intersection of 5th & Ford (by the courthouse) is underway and will continue into next week. Traffic impacts are expected to be minor.

Work is expected to begin at the intersection of Davis and 5th Street on Friday 8/12. Crews will be installing new storm sewer piping and catch basins in advance of curb extension and handicap ramp construction at this intersection. There will be traffic impacts at times for this work, with 5th Street being closed between Davis and Evans when crews install pipe across 5th Street. The traffic impacts will be limited to between 9am-3pm.
