## **NE 5<sup>th</sup> Street Improvements Project**

### **Traffic Signal Conduit and Pedestrian Push Button Pole Foundations:**

**NE 5<sup>th</sup> & Lafayette Ave, NE 5<sup>th</sup> & Evans, NE 5<sup>th</sup> & Baker, NE 5<sup>th</sup> & Adams**

Thursday October 27<sup>th</sup> through November 30<sup>th</sup>

Crews will be installing electrical and control conduits, as well as footings to support pedestrian push button poles for of the planned traffic signals along the 5<sup>th</sup> Street corridor. The conduits will be installed via trenchless directional drilling techniques, limiting the impacts on traffic.

Intermittent, short term lane restrictions may be necessary at times between 9am-3pm. Traffic control signage will be in place and access to local businesses will be maintained at all times.

Frontier Communications will continue relocating overhead communication lines in conjunction with the cities NE 5<sup>th</sup> Street Improvements Project. Work will take place on Adams St. between 4<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Streets, on 5<sup>th</sup> Street between Baker & Birch Streets, on 5<sup>th</sup> Street between Davis & Ford Streets, and at the intersection of NE 5<sup>th</sup> & Lafayette Ave. Work hours will be approximately 7am – 5pm. Lane restrictions, when necessary, will take place between 9am-3pm. Traffic control signage and detour routes will be in place and access to local businesses will be maintained at all times.

We ask that when residents put their leaves in the street they leave a one-foot area between leaves and the curb so storm water can flow to catch basins. Leaves must be loose. Debris other than leaves, such as branches, rocks, metal and lawn clippings will not be removed; scattered leaves and leaves piled under or close to parked cars cannot be collected.
