

## HANGAR TAXILANE & EAST APRON REHABILITATION PROJECT



### PROJECT OVERVIEW

#### PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- Reconstruct the hangar area taxilane, with a new structural section, to accommodate aircraft forecasted to use the hangar area;
- Reconstruct the deteriorating pavement of the east apron; and
- Replace existing tie-downs, construct drainage improvements as needed, and apply new pavement markings.

#### PROJECT ELEMENTS

- Pavement rehabilitation will involve 'full depth' demolition of existing pavement, and the construction of a new structural section.
- Duration of construction is expected to be approximately 45-60 days, depending on the size of project.
- The area of pavement rehabilitation will be determined by the availability of Federal and State agency funding.
- The project schedule is unknown at this time, and will be determined by availability of Federal and State agency funding.
- The project is currently in the environmental & preliminary design phase.

#### PROJECT FUNDING

- The City is in the process of applying for funding from both Federal and State agencies. The availability of Federal and State funding is expected to be determined in the coming months.
- The Airport receives federal funding from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) as part of the Airport Improvement Program (AIP). FAA funding will account for 90% of the overall project cost. A combination of City and State funds will account for the remaining project cost.
- The City is in the process of investigating various project alternatives, ranging in project size & cost, to accommodate the various levels of funding that could be made available for the project.




