Cook School Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project

Monday August 29th thru Friday September 2nd, road closures on Oregon Street, Oak Street, Macy Street between 9th Street and 3rd Street, Logan Street between 9th Street and 4th Street, Logan Street between Brooks Street and 1st Street,, Kirby Street between Three Mile Lane and 5th Street, 9th Street between Lafayette Ave and Oregon Street, 5th Street between Lafayette Avenue and Oregon Street, 4th Street between Lafayette Ave and Oregon Street, 3rd Street between Macy Street and Oregon Street, 2nd Court, Anne Street, 1st Street between Three Mile Lane and Anne Street, Brooks Street From Three Mile Lane to Joe Dancer Park. ROW Permit, McMinnville Water & Light

Utility Pole Replacement & Relocation -NE 5th & Adams and NE 5th & Evans

McMinnville Water & Light will continue installing and relocating utility poles in the NE 5th Street corridor in conjunction with the Cities NE 5th Street Improvements Project. Night work on Adams Street between 4th & 6th Streets will start Sunday evening Aug 28th and continue nightly through Tuesday Aug 30th. Works hours will be from 7pm to 5am to comply with ODOT permit requirements. Work on Evans Street between 4th & 6th will occur Tuesday through Thursday evenings Aug 30th through Sept 1st so crews can finish switching over power services to newly installed poles without disrupting nearby businesses. There will be intermittent lane closures. Traffic control signage will be in place and access to local businesses will be maintained at all times.
