NE Alpine Avenue Improvements

Construction on the NE Alpine Avenue Improvements Project continues. The last storm water planter just north of 8th Street has been excavated. Electrical conduit is being installed and street work between 7th & 8th is expected to June 12th. Franchise utility relocates has been slower than expected and are now anticipated to be complete by the end of June. The project is expected to be complete in the spring of 2018. Traffic control signage and detour routes will be in place throughout the project and access to local residents and businesses will be maintained around the work zones at all times.

Storm water planters, Conduit installation and Franchise Utility Relocates

Alpine Ave between 8th Street and 11th Ave

Monday June 5ththrough Friday June 9th

Crews from Emery & Sons and their subcontractors will be installing electrical conduits between 10th Avenue and 11th Avenue. The last storm water planter just north of 8th Street has been excavated and is expected to be formed and poured early in the week.

Crews from Frontier Communication and McMinnville Water & Light will be installing new utility poles between 8th Street and 11th Ave requiring the intermittent closure of sections of Alpine to through traffic between the hours of 7am-5pm. Traffic control signage and detour routes will be in place and access to local residents and businesses will be maintained at all times.

Due to a longer than anticipated lead time on the concrete reinforcing bars, the excavation and rocking of the street between 7th Ave and 8th Street is now expected to begin on June 12th. This block of Alpine will be closed for up to 35 days while crews complete the concrete and trellis foundation work.

Crews from Full Bore Inc. will be installing a conduit on the south side of 10th street between Lafayette Avenue and the gate to RB Rubber. The conduit will be directionally drilled limiting the impacts to existing landscapes and traffic. While unrelated to the Alpine Avenue Project, the conduit is being installed for future use by Light Speed Networks.
