

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: OCTOBER 13 – OCTOBER 20, 2016



NE 5th Street Improvements Project

Traffic Signal Foundations:

NW & SW Corner of 5th Street & Adams Street

Thursday October 13th and Monday October 17th

NE 5th Street will be closed to through traffic between Birch and Adams Streets from 9am to 3pm while crews drill and pour the foundations for new traffic signal poles. Traffic on Adams Street will not be impacted. Traffic control signage and detour routes will be in place and access to residences and local businesses will be maintained at all times.

SE Corner of 5th & Adams Street

Tuesday October 18th

NE 5th Street will be closed between Adams and Baker Streets on Tuesday, October 18th from 9am to 3pm while crews drill and pour the foundation for a new traffic signal pole. The extent of the closure on 5th Street will be from Adams Street east to the driveway into Citizens Bank and Dutch Brothers. This driveway will be open for use by business patrons via 5th Street westbound from Baker Street. Traffic on Adams Street will not be impacted. Traffic control signage and detour routes will be in place and access to local businesses will be maintained at all times.

NE 5th & Evans Street

Wednesday October 19th through Tuesday October 25th

Signal pole foundations will be drilled at each corner beginning Wednesday, October 19th and continue weekdays until Tuesday, October 25th. Intermittent Street closures of one block at a time may be necessary at times on 5th Street or Evans Street between 9am and 3pm. Traffic control signage and detour routes will be in place and access to local businesses will be maintained at all times.

Utility Relocation Work:

NE 5th St between Adams & Lafayette Avenue

Frontier Communications will continue relocating overhead communication lines in conjunction with the cities NE 5th Street Improvements Project. Work will take place on Adams St. between 4th

& 6th Streets, on 5th Street between Baker & Birch Streets, on 5th Street between Davis & Ford Streets, and at the intersection of NE 5th & Lafayette Ave. Work hours will be approximately 7am – 5pm. Lane restrictions, when necessary, will take place between 9am-3pm. Traffic control signage and detour routes will be in place and access to local businesses will be maintained at all times.

Sanitary Sewer & Storm Line Inspection and Cleaning (*downtown area*)

City crews will be inspecting and cleaning sanitary sewer and storm lines in this area. Work includes cleaning the lines with high pressure water and TV inspection. Traffic may be impacted due to equipment in or effecting travel lanes. If needed, lanes may be closed for brief periods of time with signs and detours posted.
