


How We Got Here

- ARPA becomes law March 2021
- 2. \$1.9 trillion funding package
 - 2.1. \$350 billion SLFRF
 - 2.2. \$21 million Yamhill County
 - 2.3. \$9.4 million MSD
 - 2.4. \$22 million Chemeketa Community College
 - 2.5. \$4 million Linfield University
 - 2.6. \$7.7 million City of McMinnville
- 3. Two prior work sessions on topic
 - 3.1. 8/16 Work Session: Presented initial list of possible projects
- 4. Detailed project investment requests developed (Attachment F)



How We Got Here (cont.) Timeline



Overview of Attachment A

- 53 Project Investment Requests submitted
- 2. High-end total of \$13,384,550
- 3. Prioritization in 3 categories
 - 3.1. High priority recommend receive ARPA-SLFRF funding
 - 3.2. Medium priority recommend receive SLFRF funding, if available
 - 3.3. Potential future investment recommend other funding sources unless additional federal funding becomes available

- 1. Categorized each project in high/medium
 - 1.1. Innovative, high impact project
 - 1.2. Immediate impact community project
 - 1.3. Internal efficiency effectiveness
- 2. Each Project Investment Request evaluated under:

 - 2.2. Investment principles adopted on 8/16/2021
 - 2.3. City values in 2032 Mac-Town Strategic Plan





Overview of Attachment A (cont.) High Priority Projects

- 2. Projects requested by AHC, MEVLC, and MWL included in high priority



Overview of Attachment A (cont.) High Priority Projects








Overview of Attachment A (cont.) Medium Priority Projects

Overview of Attachment A (cont.) Potential Future Investment Projects

- 1. 23 projects; total cost estimate: \$3 million-\$5.5 million
- 2. Likely no SLFRF remaining, unless additional federal resources
- 3. Retain list if additional/alternative funding available, but do not prioritize for SLFRF
