Campaign Finance & Disclosure Requirements

Requirements of 2.10

- .020 – Political Committees to register with Secretary of State.
- .030 – Communications to voters to “prominently disclose” source of contributions.
- .080 – Definitions, including specific requirements for “prominently disclose” as applied to printed material, videos, finance directory disclosure, website or email message, billboard or sign.

Enforcement (.050)

- Violations punishable by civil fine.
- *Any person* may file a complaint with city finance director.
- Finance Director shall investigate:
 - Notify every person who is the object of a complaint (w/in 2 days)
 - Accept written materials/evidence (10 days following notification)
 - Render a decision (10 days after close of submission period)
- If complaint is received withing 30 days prior to the election, these time periods are cut in half.
- If a violation is found, Finance Director shall issue a statement to interested parties/news organizations regarding source of contributions at issue.
