SUBJECT: Joint meeting of the City Council and McMinnville Water and Light Commission

Background:

The City Council and the McMinnville Water and Light Commission are holding a series of biannual joint meetings with a focus on learning about each organization and its respective programs. In this session, City, McMinnville Water and Light, and County staff will be giving overviews of their emergency management programs and leading an exercise.

Discussion:

In December of 2023, the City hired a part-time emergency manager to focus on emergency planning and preparation over the next three years. The program's vision is to build a safer future and a more resilient city through effective preparedness, prevention, planning, response, and recovery actions and partnerships between local government, emergency services, private sector, volunteer agencies, and the residents of The City of McMinnville.
