RESOLUTION NO. 2025-35

A Resolution authorizing the City Attorney to take all necessary actions, including the initiation of a lawsuit, to secure funds erroneously paid to Fackler Construction.

RECITALS:

Whereas, the City entered into a contract with Fackler Construction Company for construction of the AnyDoor Place Navigation Center; and

Whereas, final payment of \$181,179.99 was to be paid via two (2) two-party checks to two different subcontractors on the project; and

Whereas, the two checks were mistakenly issued as single-party checks and Fackler Construction received and deposited the full payment; and

Whereas, those funds are currently being held in escrow and the City wishes to secure the full amount to distribute to the previously specified subcontractors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McMINNVILLE, OREGON, as follows:

- 1. The City Attorney is authorized to take all necessary action, up to and including the initiation of a lawsuit, to secure \$181,179.99 in funds erroneously paid to Fackler Construction.
- 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and shall continue in full force and effect until modified, revoked, or replaced.
