**City General Elections 2020**

**MCMINNVILLE, Ore. – May 27, 2020** – The Biennial General election will be held on November 3, 2020. Terms of office for Councilor Wendy Stassens (Ward 1), Councilor Kellie Menke (Ward 2), Councilor Adam Garvin (Ward 3) and Mayor Scott Hill will expire on December 31, 2020. Council Positions for Ward 1, Ward 2, Ward 3 and Mayor will be on the November 3, 2020, General Elections ballot, and the respective ward winners of the election will serve a 4-year term that commence in January 2021 and will expire December 2024. City Council positions are non-paid, voluntary positions.

City Councilors are nominated and elected by ward. Persons interested in running for office must file a petition and collect 50 signatures of qualified, legal voters of the ward in which the candidate is running. The City's [Ward map](#) is available on the City's Website. Candidates must reside in the ward in which they are running for office, be registered voters in the state of Oregon and have lived in the City of McMinnville for 12 months immediately preceding their filing of candidate petition.
