Much thought and consideration has been spent on this decision and due to extended family health issues and to be closer to family, we are moving out of state this Spring. This resignation will be effective after the City Council meeting on May 24th.

That includes 29 years on the City Budget Committee, 12 years on the City Council including two years as Council President, and 5 ½ years as your Mayor. I have been helped and mentored by so many of you whom I call my friends and associates. With this resignation comes a departure from my association with McMinnville Water and Light, having served on their Commission for the past 5½ years. I will miss my association with this fine organization that I call family and the numerous other boards and associations I have worked with, including the Yamhill County Parkway Commission. I wish the very best to those who continue and those who will come, as we have all worked and continue to work on the livability and sustainability of this Community. Thank you for the opportunity.
