**Parking Structure:**

There were 12 Area Checks of the parking structure this week.

There were 3 self-initiated / calls for service.

01/31/18 at 0826 – Dumping Complaint – An MPD Sergeant cited a subject for Offensive Littering. This subject had parked a vehicle in the structure and took up numerous parking spaces with his belongings and garbage.

02/03/18 at 2031 – Mental Health Subject – While on an area check an Officer came across a subject who was experiencing a mental health crisis. Community Outreach was called and the subject requested a voluntary hospital evaluation which he assisted him with.

02/04/18 at 1432 – Drug – An MPD Officer was dispatched to a report of a 60 year old male and 50 year old female smoking methamphetamine. The officer was unable to locate the subjects who had reportedly been doing drugs.

### **Library / Aquatic Center:**

01/31/18 at 1642 – Intoxicated Subject – Officers responded to a report of an intoxicated male. It doesn't appear anyone was located.

02/02/18 at 1017 – Suspicious – Officers responded to a report of a HMA, 6'04" and 250 lbs, who was twitching and clenching and acting nervous. He was reportedly trying vehicle doors in the parking lot. They located the male. Although he was not arrested on this occasion, he was arrested in Lafayette and is currently in custody for an unrelated matter.

02/02/18 at 1105 – Welfare Check – Officers checked on a subject who was stating he couldn't remember who he was or how to get home. The subject was located, and identified and given a ride home. It sounds like resources were contacted for the subject being a candidate for Project Lifesaver.

02/02/18 at 2240 – Theft / Recovered Stolen Property – Officers contacted a subject who located his daughter's bike which was stolen a week ago from their residence but never reported.

02/03/18 at 1240 – Suspicious – Officers responded on a report that the subject who was looking in cars the day before was back and sitting in the plaza.

02/03/18 at 1309 – Suspicious – Officers contacted the subject who reported his daughter's bike stolen as it was currently locked up with a Library lock.
