Airport Economic Strategic Plan (Anne Pagano and Willy Williamson)

Willy Williamson, McMinnville Airport Manager, discussed the Airport Master Plan, which was just getting started in the process. They planned to take an inventory of the airport and the focus of the plan was the needed infrastructure, identifying obstructions, activities, and community needs. They would also create an implementation plan. He discussed challenges with funding and FAA requirements for activities.

There was discussion regarding incorporating economic development, the Three Mile Lane development plan, and innovation center into the master plan process. There was further

discussion regarding the biggest opportunities at the airport, aviation related industries for the Three Mile Lane expansion, developing shovel ready sites for ancillary businesses, intention for the innovation center, scope of the project, property owned by the airport, state involvement in the plan, building a new terminal, electric airplanes and infrastructure, income resources, community engagement and advisory committee, hanger space and rents, examples of other city airports, demand for hangars in the region, and other uses for the hangers.

Community Development Director Richards said this was a priority of the committee and they wanted to help in the effort, such as creating a business plan.
