Patty Herzog, McMinnville Economic Development Partnership, presented a case for hiring a full-time Work Force Development Coordinator to address McMinnville's workforce challenges and opportunities. She discussed the strategic importance and key responsibilities and benefits of this position, internship programs, strategic leadership in Workforce Integration Network Advisory Council, data-driven decision making, resource management and outreach, and proposed structure and budget.

There was discussion regarding examples of other communities that had this position, how this position would be housed in MEDP, advantages of the position, timeframe, potential funding sources, data that showed successes and value of the work, setting up a task force of MEVLC to develop a funding proposal to create this dedicated role, and who should serve on the task force.

The tentative list for the task force was: John Olsen, Craig Brockett, Carson Benner, Mike Morris, Devon Paolo, City staff, a hospitality representative, and Lauren Berg from the School District.

Housing Production Work Force Housing Focus Group. (Evan Hietpas)
