GENERAL PROVISIONS:

1. CALL THE APPROVED AGENCY TWO BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO START OF WORK.
See below.
2. Traffic control shall conform to the requirements of the MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES.
3. Pavement cutting will not be allowed without prior approval; approval will be given on a case basis only.
4. Open cuts of pavement shall be patched with cold mix or covered with steel plates to accommodate traffic overnight or until the final hot patch is constructed.
5. All trenching and pavement cuts shall be guaranteed against settlement.
6. A copy of an approved permit and construction drawings must be on the job at all times that work is being performed.
7. Oregon State Law requires you follow rules adopted by the Oregon Utility Notification Center. Those rules are set forth in OAR952-001-0010 through OAR952-001-0090. You may obtain copies of the rules by calling the center at 503-232-1987 or 1-800-332-2344.

The applicant shall indemnify and save harmless the City of McMinnville, its Council, its agents officers, and employees from all suits and actions; claims of any character brought because of injuries or damages received or sustained by any person or property on account of the operations of the said Applicant, his Subcontractors, or the employees of either, or on account of consequence of any neglect in safeguarding the work; or because of any act or omission, neglect, or misconduct of the said Applicant.

The Applicant accepts and approves the terms and provisions contained and attached, including the special provisions and the Approving Agency's adopted Designs Standards. Permits for construction expire six (6) months from the date of issue.
