**SUBJECT:** City Employees and Volunteers --- FTEs and Numbers

**Introduction** --- The three tables following this memo analyze City full and part-time employees and City volunteers in several different ways. Integral to these table analyses is the definition of Full-Time Equivalent (FTE). One FTE is equivalent to one full-time employee working one full year. FTEs are calculated for part-time employees using a 40-hour workweek and a 52-week work year. To help ease of comparison between the tables, the 2004-05 fiscal year column is shaded in each table.

**Table #1 --- Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Employees – Full and Part-Time:** This FTE analysis compares the total number of employee FTEs working in each department for the last four years with the 2005-2006 Proposed Budget FTE. The FTEs include full-time and part-time employees. Table #1 allows you to easily compare specific department changes remembering a full-time equivalent is specifically defined as 2,080 employee work hours per year; i.e. 8 hours per day x 5 days per week x 52 weeks per year.

**Table #2 --- Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Volunteers:** Many City departments rely heavily on volunteers. Of particular note are the Fire Department, Parks and Recreation Departments, Police Department, and Library, as illustrated by Table #2. The FTE's are primarily estimated from historical hours worked by volunteers with adjustments for operational changes.

**Table #3 --- Total Number of Employees and Volunteers:** Table #3 totals the actual number of people working for each City department in 2004-2005 in all the various personal services capacities --- full-time employees, part-time employees, and volunteers.

**Table #3 Addendum** --- The Volunteer Roster further breaks-down the volunteers by department and type of work and gives important additional explanation regarding some of the volunteer groups.

**Summary** --- Although the full and part-time FTE's for 2004-2005 is 200.89 (178.57 + 22.32), the actual number of individuals involved with providing City services is 1,255.
