



## **McMinnville Fire Department Volunteer Requirements**

### **VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS PRIOR TO ACCEPTANCE**

1. Fill out Application
2. Background Check
3. Panel Interview
4. Physical Ability Test
5. Notification of Acceptance

### **VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS AFTER ACCEPTANCE**

#### **Wednesday night Drills and Meetings**

7-9:30pm every Wednesday night.

New Firefighters are required to be at every Wednesday night drill for one year unless prior arrangements are made with one of the Training Captains.

#### **Firefighter I Academy**

Firefighter I Academy is a County wide academy that McMinnville participates in every spring. This academy takes 15 days to complete and is usually set up for every other weekend, taking up both Saturday and Sunday until completed.

New Firefighters must attend every fire academy class. If two days are missed for any reason, you will be dismissed from the Volunteer Firefighter program.

New Firefighters cannot miss any portion of the Hazardous Material or Wildland firefighting classes. These are multi day classes and missing any portion of these classes will not allow you to receive credit for the class.

### **VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS AFTER THE FIRST YEAR**

Volunteer Firefighters are required to attend a minimum of 60% of all Wednesday night drills and meetings.

Volunteer Firefighters are required to respond to a minimum of 20% of fire calls that a volunteer response is requested.

All combat Firefighters are required to take a medical physical exam annually. This exam will be paid for by the city.
