

ORDINANCE NO. 23-1

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CAREER AND VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS AND OTHER DISTRICT EMPLOYEES AND VOLUNTEERS FROM SERVING AS A DISTRICT DIRECTOR

WHEREAS, ORS 478.050 establishes that a district may determine by ordinance that firefighters of the district, volunteer, career or otherwise, and other district employees and volunteers are not eligible to serve as a district director; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance was included in the published agenda for the meeting and the agenda was published not more than 10 days nor less than four days prior to the meeting in a newspaper of general circulation in Yamhill County as required by ORS 198.540; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance was read during regular meetings of the district board on two different days at least six days apart as required by ORS 198.550; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance will take effect more than one year prior to the date of a regular district election; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the McMinnville Fire District has determined that such regulations are beneficial to the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MCMINNVILLE FIRE DISTRICT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH 198.510-198.600, ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. No firefighter, career or volunteer, or any other employee or volunteer of the District shall be eligible to serve as District Director
2. This Ordinance will take effect 30 days after passage by the Board of Directors.
3. The recording secretary of the district board, after attesting the same, shall file this ordinance in the records of the district and cause a certified copy to be filed with the county clerk.
