

Library Children's Technology Use

Revised May 2026

The McMinnville Public Library has a designated space for children under 12 to use and access technology in the Children's Room.

- All computers are for children aged 12 and under.
- Children 0 through 9 years of age must be supervised by an attentive caregiver 13 or older while using the computers and tablets.
- Children 10 through 12 years of age may use computers and tablets without supervision.
- Children are limited to 60-minutes maximum for both computers and tablets.
- Internet use may be extended for school projects and homework.
- Children must be present to make reservations for computers.
- Print copies are 10 cents for black and white and 50 cents for color.
- Only two people at a terminal at one time.
- Children's Internet computers are filtered.

NOTE ON INTERNET SAFETY

The library does not monitor or control all the information accessed through the internet; however, software and filters may be put in place at the discretion of the library to block obscene content or malicious code/spyware. No filtering technology is absolute; therefore, there is no guarantee that filters will block materials that patrons may find objectionable. Adult supervision is advised.
