

RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 21

A Resolution appointing Heather Sharfeddin to the Historic Landmarks Committee.

RECITALS:

The City of McMinnville has several Boards, Committees, Commissions, and Task Forces made up of volunteers; and

The City of McMinnville believes that the preservation of historic and cultural resources is a local value of the community that would best be served by a committee of volunteers dedicated to historic preservation efforts specific to the City of McMinnville; and

In order to implement its McMinnville Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 17.65 (Historic Preservation), the McMinnville City Council appoints a volunteer Historic Landmarks Committee that reviews and makes decisions and/or recommendations on the identification and protection of historic resources in the City of McMinnville; and

There is currently one vacancy on the Historic Landmarks Committee that needs to be filled; and

The City advertised the vacancies, solicited applications and held interviews.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCMINNVILLE, OREGON as follows:**

1. The City Council appoints the following volunteer to the Historic Landmarks Committee for a term of four years expiring on December 31, 2021.
2. This Resolution and this appointment will take effect immediately.
