PREVIOUS LAND FILL ACTIVITY


- Current plan claims no fill activity. This seems ingenuine.
- There are at least three fill areas, one that was permitted


TWO KNOWN FILL AREAS

WIDENING PINOT NOIR TO PLANNED ROW

- Enforcing the right of way boundary may not require the use of Eminent Domain powers, but the result is the same to the people impacted. Without their knowledge, these property owners have been enjoying their lots as constructed by the city years ago.
- How far will this new construction go into the existing front yards of these homes?
- Will the sidewalk be moved? If not, will it be against the curb?
