Police Department Lobby Closure to Slow the Spread of COVID-19

We understand there is much apprehension within the community concerning the outbreak of COVID-19. We have carefully considered all the practical information shared by public health officials, and we are taking steps to ensure your public safety services continue.

Based on the guidance from public health officials we are closing the front lobby of the Police Department to minimize and reduce the COVID-19 transmission.

Those who come to the police department to report information during business hours can call (503)434-7307 to reach our front office, or for after- hours assistance citizens can utilize the after hour phone to request contact or call the non-emergency dispatch center (503)434-6500.

Should any resident need to come to the police department for service, we are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Residents can also file numerous types of incidents online. Please understand that these measures are only temporary. We will continue to monitor the situation in partnership and guidance from our local public health officials. These changes will be revisited, and when possible, lifted.
