• **Discussion:** Jody Christensen (JC) introduced new PAC Members: Marilyn Kosel and Scott Cunningham

• **Discussion:** Doris Towery provided an update on business resilience activities.

3. Discussion - What are your concerns about Third Street's infrastructure?

- **Discussion:** The PAC noted the following concerns:
 - Stormwater/drainage issues
 - Lack of public restrooms
 - Cracked/broken sidewalks
 - Trees damaging streets and sidewalks
 - Accessibility
 - Waste management
 - Parking
 - Commercial vehicle loading and unloading
 - Underground tanks/hazardous materials
 - Street lighting

4. Existing Conditions Presentation

• **Discussion:** BKF and SERA presented the existing conditions documentation performed to date.

5. Street Tree Considerations

- **Discussion:** The PAC asked if the team had examples of similar projects where trees were successfully preserved.
- Action: SERA and BKF to research past similar projects where trees were successfully preserved.
- **Discussion:** Walt Gowell (WG) suggested the following criteria for assessing tree removal/ preservation
 - Condition
 - Likelihood to damage new sidewalk
 - Visibility of existing business signs
 - Death probability
 - Likely post-construction life span
 - Conflicts with proposed infrastructure



- **Action**: **SERA** and **BKF** to validate tree removal/ preservation criteria with the project arborist and suggest additional criteria.
- **Discussion:** PAC requested a future section at post-construction timelines (1, 5, 10, and 20-year). The committee discussed an additional meeting to develop a tree decision criteria matrix to be used by the consultants in preparation for the 02.01.24 meeting's recommendations.
- **Action:** SERA to provide sections at post-construction timelines (1, 5, 10, and 20-year) with future deliverables.
