
What We Do For You

Example: for 300 cubic feet of water use, the bill would be:

\$24.57

19.98 [\$6.66 x (300 CF/100)]

\$44.55

MONTHLY BILL

Consumption-based averaging allows residential customers to use water as needed (for instance irrigation) during the summer months without affecting the monthly sewer charges. For billing periods during the winter months (December - March), sewer charges are billed according to actual water consumption. To account for irrigation and other water used during the remaining months (April - November) that is not treated, charges are based on the average of the winter months' water use or actual water use, whichever is less.

Rates are established using analysis and equity reviews for sanitary sewer rates, which are conducted biennially to ensures that the actual revenues and expenses are meeting the needs of McMinnville's growing population.

The latest review was completed in 2022. The findings from the study indicate a rate increase of 2.5 percent starting July 1, 2023 and annually thereafter was needed.

Sanitary sewer fees are set by resolutions. The most recent resolution was passed by the City Council increasing the sewer user fees by 2.5 percent effective July 1, 2025.

To meet some of the most stringent requirements in the state under the regulatory permit issued by Oregon DEQ, sewer user fees are used to:

- operate, maintain and repair the City's wastewater treatment plant -- Water Reclamation Facility (WRF), sewer lines, and pump stations;
- fund major capital projects in the sewer system and at the WRF;
- provide building improvements; and
- replace aging equipment.

Monitored Commercial/Industrial customers will be billed based on an assigned wastewater strength classification.

Residential Septic Waste rate is \$0.15 per gallon -hauled by permitted commercial service providers.
