Did You Know ...

Sewer user fees are used to operate and maintain the City's wastewater treatment plant -- Water Reclamation Facility (WRF), which meets some of the most stringent regulatory permit requirements in the state. Additionally, the fees are used to maintain and repair the City's sewer lines and pump stations.

The City conducts sanitary sewer rate analysis and equity reviews biennially to ensures that the actual revenues and expenses are meeting the needs of McMinnville's growing population.

The most recent study for fiscal year 2021-22 concluded that after no increases since 2019, a rate increase of 2.5 percent is recommended. Sanitary sewer fees are set by resolutions, which are approved by City Council. City Council approved the resolution to increase the fees by 2.5 percent along with a 1 percent increase to the wastewater franchise fee for a total increase of 3.5 percent and will be effective July 1, 2023.

In addition, these fees are used to fund major capital projects in the sewer system and at the WRF, provide building improvements, and replace aging equipment.

For 300 cubic feet of water use, the bill would be: \$23.16 - Monthly Sewer Customer Charge <u>18.84</u> - Flow Based Charges [\$6.28 x (300 CF/100)]

\$42.00 - Total Sewer Charges

Residential Septic Waste rate is \$0.15 per gallon -hauled by permitted commercial service providers.

CONSUMPTION-BASED AVERAGING

Consumption-based averaging allows residential customers to use water as needed during the summer months without affecting the monthly sewer charges. For billing periods during the winter months (December - March), sewer charges are billed according to actual water consumption. Charges for the remaining months (April - November) are based on the average of the winter months' water use or actual water use, whichever is less.
